<u>SUPERINTENDENT'S</u> <u>REPORT</u>: Superintendent Glaze reported OSBA is looking to fill a Board Director position for the La Grande and greater eastern Oregon area. The position is for a two year term. Election information can be obtained from the District Office. It has been a busy summer; Administrators and two teachers from Greenwood participated in a PLC Training in Seattle, Janel Keating presented a one day training in La Grande and Superintendent Glaze, John Tolan, Holly Wagner, Toban Goodin and Sophia

Thompson gave a PLC Presentation at the Summer Assessment Institute in Eugene. In addition, Oregon was one of ten finalist out of one hundred applicants who applied for a K-12 Education Philanthropy Initiative Request for a 7 million dollar grant through the Business Roundtable (BRT). Superintendent Glaze along with Mickey Garrison and Cheryl Williamson recently returned from a trip to Washington D.C where they presented their plan for scaling up data project work and to respond to questions from the panel. The BRT believes there are many examples of successful education programs across the country that demonstrate it is possible to generate results for all students, including those who are poor, minority, disabled and non-English speaking. The purpose of this initiative is to identify and scale up a small number of high-performing K-12 programs that address critical education and workforce preparedness issues. Ms. Garrison applied for the grant for the state of Oregon to take the data project work (PLC) and continue to spread throughout Oregon. This grant would help promote PLC's in the seven regions in Oregon, Washington and Idaho. The final four recipients will be announced in September.
